U15 at the "Nelson Mandela Sports Complex" (SCHILTIGHEIM), U13 to "Branko" Karabatic and Permanent Hall" (STRASBOURG), U11 at the "Herrade Hall" (STRASBOURG). End of the matches around **08:00 pm**. Indicative times.

### Sunday, February 01

From 09:00 am, final stages Girls and Boys, Doubles followed by Singles. All the matches to the "Nelson Mandela Sports Complex" (SCHILTIGHEIM). End of the matches around **03:00 pm** (prize ceremony included). Indicative times.

# TOURNAMENT REGULATIONS

### I - GENERAL REGULATIONS

This tournament will be played in full accordance with the Laws of Badminton, the Tournament Regulations as defined by FFBaD (Badminton French Federation, see:

https://www.ffbad.org/lafederation-textes-officiels-le-guide-du-badminton

The U11 series will be played on the same regulated courts as the U13 and U15 with nets at 1.55m, and the entire play area.

# II - SPECIFIC REGULATIONS

### A/ Participants

- 1- Players, members of a Badminton Federation associated with the BWF, are entitled to take part to the tournament.
- 2- The tournament will be played in the age categories U11/U13/U15. Participants must not exceed the appropriate age limits presented on the previous page.
- 3- For French players, the single minimum ranking is **D7 in U13 boy**, **D8 in U13 girl**, and R6 in U15 boy, D7 in U15 girl, on the date the CPPH (permanent classification by point) is taken into account. In doubles, the limits are those of the French regulations.

## B/ System of play and disciplines

- 1- In each age category, the following events will be played: men's singles, women's singles, men's doubles, women's doubles and mixed doubles.
- 2- A player can only register in one age category (except mixed), in each category or in the immediately higher category.

Registration for 3 events is allowed.

4- In **Singles**, in all series, the first round will be played in qualifying groups, and the following rounds are played in the knock-out-system, regardless of the number of participants (FFBAD exemption).

A waiting list will eventually be made up, in case of high attendance.

- 5- Doubles (just one series) will be played according to the knock-out system.
- 6- Mixed (just one series) will be played according to the knock-out system.
- 7- In all age categories the minimum number of entries required in any event is set to 12 boys and 12 girls. The tournament management might have to cancel an event in an age category or discipline if the minimum number of entries has not been received.
- 8- The loosing player of a match will automatically score the following match on that court or she/he will arrange an adequate replacement.

# C/ Shuttles

- 1- The "BABOLAT 2" is the official tournament shuttlecock in all age categories.
- 2- Shuttlecocks from other brands or other specifications are not allowed.
- 3- In the age categories U11 and U13, 2 shuttlecocks will be provided by the tournament organization for each match.
- 4- In the age categories U15, 4 shuttlecocks will be provided for each match.
- 5- Beyond the shuttlecocks provided on each game, the extra shuttlecocks are the responsibility of the players. Sharing must be done equally.
- 6- Tournament shuttles can be purchased at match control.
- 7- The shuttlecocks will be provided for the finals.

#### E/ Entries

- 1- The number of entries for the different age groups will be limited in accordance with the maximum number of matches that can be played in the assigned venue. # BFIB 2026 Documents

- 3- Entries for foreign and French players will be accepted according to the following order of precedence:
  - a) Members of National teams
- b) By national rank in each country, and for foreigners the French ranking and the points awarded for this competition
- 4- Registration closes on December 19, 2025. After the registration deadline, it is no longer possible to register new players or pairs.

However, only for the U11, in order to promote this category, it will be possible to accept the U11 until the day before the seeding, only in the U11 draws whose capacity is not reached.

5- In case of too many entries in an age group, the tournament organization makes the final decision to accept or reject an entry. Not accepted players will be informed December 26, by mail. Rejected entries will be placed on a waiting list.

For all group entries it's necessary to give an order of strength by using the group entry list, we need that information in case of rejecting.

- 6- The entry fees in the all age categories are € 30,00 per person for singles and € 20,00 per person per event in doubles.
- 7- For players licensed in France, the entry fees must be paid using exclusively the BadNet link above (used when registering), no later than January 22, 2026.

- 8- For players not licensed in France, the entry fees must be paid according 2 possibilities:
- either they paid the entry fees by BadNet, when registering players on BadNet (no later than 22 January 2026),
- or when the organizer receives the player registration form, the IBAN account ("Ligue Grand est de Badminton LGEBaD-FIB") will be sent by email to pay the entry fees (no later than January 22, 2026).
- 9- Sending us an e-mail immediately after paying the entry fee including a list of players you've payed for is required. Important in this e-mail is also the name of country or group and your own name.

# F/ Seeding and draw and clothing regulations

- 1- Seeding is done by or under the responsibility of Headn Referee.
- 2- The draw will be published on January 18 and will be made according to the RGC ("Règlement Général des Compétions de la FFBaD").
- 3- Playing is only allowed in clothing listed below:
  - polo shirt, T-shirt or tank top;
  - short for boy and short or skirt for girl;
