GENERAL**TOURNAMENT SCHEDULE**

Friday, 30 January 2026: Mixed doubles begin at 11:30 a.m. in Schiltigheim.

Saturday, 31 January 2026: Starting at 8:30 a.m., men's singles and women's singles will begin, followed by men's doubles and women's doubles at the three competition venues (U15 – Schiltigheim / U13 – Robertsau / U11 – Herrade).

Sunday, 1 February 2026: From 9:00 a.m. in Schiltigheim, Final Stages (Semi-finals then Finals) for men's doubles and women's doubles, followed by the Men's Singles and Women's Singles Finals.



RULES OF CONDUCT:

A/ Respect

B/ Fair play and sportsmanship

If you believe that a mistake has been made, you may report it at the end of the match in a respectful and constructive manner in order to obtain a clear explanation. C/ Respect for the premises:

Given the large number of participants, we ask that you refrain from eating in the stands and keep your belongings as compact as possible to leave space for everyone. Dedicated dining areas will be set up for this purpose.

The cleaning of the premises is carried out by volunteers who give their time and energy. We thank you for helping to keep these areas clean and pleasant so that everyone can enjoy their meals in a welcoming environment.

D/ Punctuality:

It is therefore important to follow these guidelines to ensure that each match starts on time and that the tournament runs smoothly and orderly.
